The opioid epidemic continues to affect

Greater Than Heroin, a continuing outreach of the FEST, is a group of churches, nonprofits, businesses, and other organizations seeking to bring understanding, awareness, and collaboration to the heroin and opioid drug epidemic in Northeast Ohio. The FEST and Greater Than Heroin have hosted community discussions and promoted bi-annual Drug Take-Back Days, encouraging individuals to clean out their cabinets and dispose of unused prescription drugs by taking them to local police departments.

I was decided that I would give it to a person on the street who was homeless and hungry. I included plastic silverware and a note in the full bag of left over food. The note said that God loves everyone, including those who are poor, and so do I. I got out of my car with a large bag of food and two liters of drinking water. I approached a lady sitting near a tree, with a bag of her belongings. I asked if she wanted food and water and she said "yes, but I'm sorry you have to see me like this." I didnt know what she meant until she turned her face toward me. She took down her hoodie and revealed a swollen, bruised face with dried blood on it. Some teeth appeared missing. I asked her if she was going to be ok and she said yes. I told her i would pray for her. We said the "our father" before I left her and the food. - MARY C.
