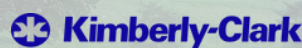
Q: What if I can no longer work my shift?

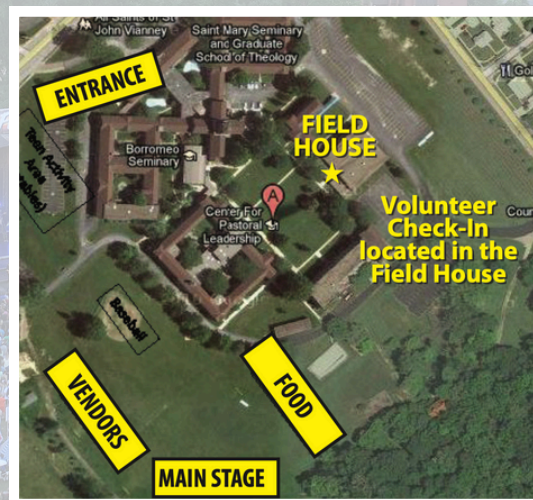
Check-in for all volunteers is located at the Field House. (See the map below)

If you have any role in The FEST Mass (Eucharistic Minister, usher, etc.), please check in at the Field House before 6:00 p.m. You will receive a nametag and a volunteer shirt.

Ushers will meet at the Issenman Gym at 7:00 p.m. Please make sure personal belongings (chairs, blankets, large bags, etc.) have been previously set up on the main field or left with family/friends, to ensure you can carry your love bucket without hassle.

Eucharistic Ministers need to check in at the Field House no later than 6:00 p.m. to receive their station assignment tag for Mass. *Only 100 Extraordinary Ministers are needed.*

SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety is our #1 priority at The FEST. You can help us keep everyone safe by doing the following things:

- If you encounter a lost child, escort them to an information booth or First Aid tent. Only escort a lost child with another adult.
- Make sure you know where the First Aid tent is located at the end of vendor row.
